Mission Positioning

The Haven Reintegration Home is designed as an adult reintegration home that supports stability, structure, accountability, and community connection. The model is adult-first with a veteran specialty, allowing the program to serve broader adult transition needs while remaining especially responsive to veterans and justice-involved adults.
