Preliminary Fit

Referral Indicator	What to prepare
Adult in transition needing housing stability	Current housing situation, urgency, safety concerns, and desired timeline.
Veteran status or justice-involved background, if applicable	Referral source, veteran/service context, reentry context, and support needs.
Appropriate for supervised independent living	Ability to participate in rules, routines, appointments, and reintegration planning.
Not seeking nursing-level or acute clinical care	Any medical, mental-health, or behavioral risks should be disclosed in a secure follow-up process, not through public forms.

Referral Readiness Checklist

Referral source name and organization | Preferred contact information | Adult referral summary | Veteran status, if applicable | Justice-involved context, if applicable | Housing need and urgency | Known support providers | Immediate safety or placement concerns | Desired next step

Do not send Social Security numbers, court records, protected health information, medical records, or highly sensitive documents through a public website form. Submit only a basic inquiry first.
